

Privacy Policy

International Syalons (Newcastle) Ltd. understands the importance of privacy and the security of your personal information. Because of that, this policy sets out what we do with your information and what we do to keep it secure. It also explains where and how we collect your personal information, as well as your rights over any personal information we hold about you.

This policy applies if you use our products or services, or communicate with us over the phone, online or via email, by using our website or interacting with us on social media. This policy gives effect to our commitment to protect your personal information.

Who are we?

When we say 'we' or 'us' in this policy, we are referring to:

International Syalons (Newcastle) Ltd. (Registered offices: Stephenson Street, Willington Quay, Wallsend, Tyne and Wear, NE28 6TT, UK).

What information do we hold?

Information that you provide to us such as; your name, address, telephone number, email address, bank account and payment card details, employer details, job role; Information about the products or services that we have provided to you (including for example, the goods we have provided to you, when and what you paid, and the way you use our products and services etc.);

How do we use your information?

The information we collect may be used to:

- Make available our services to you;
- Process your orders;
- Take payments;
- Help us ensure that our customers are genuine and to prevent fraud;
- Conduct market research, either ourselves or with reputable agencies;
- For statistical analysis;
- Help us understand more about you as a customer, the products and services you use;
- Find ways to improve our Services, stores apps and websites;
- Provide you with online advertising;
- Provide for the safety and security of our colleagues and customers;
- Help answer your questions and solve any issues you have.



Our Website

Our website (www.syalons.com) uses Google Analytics. This is a commonly used analysis service from Google Inc. that uses cookies, which are text files saved to your computer that make it possible to analyse how you use the website.

Cookies are a technology that can be used to tailor information from a website to meet your needs. You can instruct your browser to accept or refuse cookies via your browser settings. You can prevent cookies from being saved by adjusting your browser settings; however, in this case you may not be able to use all functions offered on this website. In addition, you can prevent the data generated by the cookie related to your use of this website from being sent to and processed by Google by downloading and installing the browser add-on available via www.google.com. Google Analytics automatically saves the name of your ISP, the web page that referred you to us, the web pages you visit on our website as well as the date and duration of your visit. We use Google Analytics to better understand visitor preferences and optimally design its web pages.

We do not use our website to gather personal information, unless you have contacted us through our website, however if we require personal information from you we will notify you of this in advance.

Who might we share your information with?

Our Service Providers

We work with partners, suppliers, insurers and agencies so they can process your personal information on our behalf, but only where they meet our standards on the processing of data and security. We only share information that allows them to provide their services to us or to facilitate them providing their services to you.

Other Organisations and Individuals

We may transfer your personal information to other organisations in certain scenarios. For example:

If we're discussing selling or transferring part or all of a business, we may share information about you to prospective purchasers - but only so they can evaluate that business;

If we are reorganised or sold to another organisation, we may transfer information we hold about you to them so they can continue to provide the Services to you;

If required to by law, under any code of practice by which we are bound or we are asked to do so by a public or regulatory authority such as the Police or the Department for Work and Pensions;

If we need to do so in order to exercise or protect our legal rights, users, systems and Services; or

In response to requests from individuals (or their representatives) seeking to protect their legal rights or the rights of others.

Your Rights

Access and Correction of Your Personal Information
